On February 2, 2006, former US Trade Representative Rob Portman, announced that the US intends to enter into negotiations with the Republic of Korea toward a Korea – US Free Trade Agreement (KORUS FTA). The agreement, if signed could be the most significant free trade agreement since NAFTA. Since the announcement both sides have concluded three rounds of negotiations, and hope to put the finishing touches on a deal by the end of the year.
